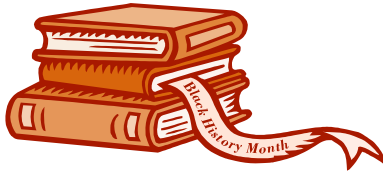
Rules and Expectations while participating in the Homework Club:

Parents: please keep this to remind you of the rules.

- 1. All forms must be completed before the student is allowed to participate in the club.**
2. Students must arrive with homework and, once homework is completed, students are expected to return home. Students will be picked up at a designated time or will walk home on their own (permission form must be completed). Tutors are not responsible for finding work for the students to do. The Homework Club operates to help students with their homework and is not to be used as a child care service.
3. Parent/guardian is asked to check in with the tutor, when dropping their child(ren) off, regarding the student's homework. Parents of students from BCES may wish to send a note in with the students to advise the tutors of what to work on.

4. Students are to respect the environment, equipment, the tutors/volunteers and other students participating in the Homework Club. Access to the Internet is strictly for school work purposes. Printing will be supervised and keep to a minimum.
5. Parent/guardian **must** leave a number where they can be reached during the Homework Club so that the child can contact their parent/guardian for pick-up, in the event of an emergency or for other concerns.
6. Students are responsible for bringing their own pencils, pens, paper and any other supplies required to complete their homework, this includes resource books and school text books. The library books and resources are out of bounds as is returning to their classroom to retrieve items.
